The COVID-19 pandemic has disrupted every aspect of our lives. Even before the onset of the crisis, the social and economic integration of young people was an ongoing challenge. Now, unless urgent action is taken, young people are likely to suffer severe and long-lasting impacts of the pandemic. The study finds the impact of the pandemic on young people to be systematic, deep and disproportionate.

Many children and young people have experienced loneliness during lockdown and in particular, have been affected by lack of physical contact with their friends, families and peers, and the boredom and frustration associated with a loss of all activities they had been used to taking part in.

2020 has probably been the strangest year of so many people's lives with the global Covid-19 pandemic, subsequent lockdown and quarantine forcing the majority of the population to stay indoors. For young people this has been especially difficult, as we have not experienced anything like this before. This was at the time when the COVID-19 pandemic had rapidly been translated into an economic crisis.
