***INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER ORGANISATION OF EXAMINATIONS AT THE CENTRE**

A] For the conduct of University theory examinations following infrastructure & facilities are necessary at the centres of examination.

- (1) Strong room**
- (2) Almirah with locking system**
- (3) Computer Latest configuration with web camera**
- (4) Laptop latest configuration with web camera**
- (5) (a) Printer / Scanner (b) Photocopier**
- (6) High speed internet / Dongal**
- (7) CCTV at strong room and college premises**
- (8) UPS atleast two hour backup**
- (9) Mobile nos atleast one number is permanent (for examination work)**
- (10) Email-id permanent (for examination work)**
- (11) Fire Extinguisher**

B] Appointment of Chief Supervisor and His Duties –

1. (a) **“Chief Supervisor”** means and includes Principal of the college concerned or head of the recognised institution concerned, where the University examination is being conducted or a senior teacher duly recommended by the Principal/Head of the recognised institution on his behalf and appointed as Chief Supervisor of the University examination by the University/Competent Authorities.

(b) The Principal/approved officiating Principal of the college where the University examination centre is located shall be the Chief Supervisor for the University examinations.

Provided that if substitute appointment is required to be made under exceptional circumstances, the Principal shall recommend the name of a senior teacher of his college for the appointment as Chief Supervisor. However, the Principal of the college shall alone be responsible for maintaining discipline at the College Campus and for any lapses occurring at the examination centre during the conduct of examinations.

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Provided further that if no Principal/ approved officiating Principal is available, University shall appoint any other person as Chief Supervisor for conducting University examinations. He shall be responsible for maintaining discipline and for any lapses occurring during the conduct of examinations.

2. The Chief Supervisor of the University examination centre shall ensure that :-

- (i) The University examination is to be conducted at the centre approved by University as per the norms laid down by the University from time to time.
- (ii) Instruction(s) / direction(s) issued by the University from time to time with regard to smooth conduction of University examination are scrupulously followed.
- (iii) The examination premises are well protected so that no trace passers or out siders can enter in the premises unnoticed.
- (iv) Seating arrangement of examinees in each room / hall are to be made as per the norms laid down by the University.
- (v) The Police protection to the examination centre is to be sought.
- (vi) No way is available to the examinee to try to resort any unfair means during the conduction of examination.
- (vii) Each Answer-book possesses a serial number on the cover page.
- (viii) The Answer-books supplied to the examinees are in good condition i.e. the pages of the Answer-book supplied to the examinee during the examination are serially numbered and without any loose page(s).
- (ix) The invigilators are appointed as per the norms laid down by the University.
- (x) Question papers are downloded and printed half an hour before which are due for the particular shift of the day / date of the examination as per time table.
- (xi) The invigilator are instructed daily to check the condition of the Answer-books before noting the roll number of the examinee and serial number of the Answer-book issued to him/her. If there is any

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discrepancie(s) in the Answer-book, the invigilator should be directed to bring it to the notice of the Chief Supervisor.

- (xii) The invigilators are signing the cover page of the Answer-books at the required place and are also signing at the end of the last written page by the examinee and are cancelling the blank page(s) of the Answer-book by drawing a line across the blank page(s).
- (xiii) The Internal Supervisor is taking rounds continuously of all the rooms where the examination is conducted to avoid the use of unfair means.
- (xiv) Physical search is being conducted regularly to detect incriminating material possessed by the examinee, if any, during the examination.
- (xv) The Internal Supervisor shall remain present atleast half an hour before the start of the examination, during the examination and while receiving the Answer-books from the invigilator(s) 'after the examination and checking the Answer-books received with the Control Sheets, noting down the roll numbers of examinees absent and finally preparing the bundle of the Answer-books alongwith control sheets having noted roll numbers of examinees absent on them.
- (xvi) The account of the advances received from the University from time to time are to be submitted within 15 days from the day of closure of examination at his centre.
- (xvii) The unfair means cases are reported to the University on the same day in the prescribed proforma giving detailed report of the concerned case and his opinion thereon alongwith copying material seized from the examinee duly signed by the examinee, the Invigilator(s), the Internal Supervisor and himself.
- (xviii) The Invigilators or any other person(s) should not help students/ examinees in using unfair means.
- (xix) Question(s)/question paper should not be leaked whether intentionally or due to negligence.

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- (xx) Answer-books without Sr. Number on cover page, having loose page(s), etc. are cancelled and not issued to examinees/students.
 - (xxi) Necessary co-operation/information is given to the vigilance squad(s) or member of Board of Examinations & Evaluations or any other person(s) authorised by the Board of Examinations & Evaluations in carrying out the inspection of the examination centre.
3. The bundle of blank answer books shall be in the custody of the Chief Supervisor of the examination centre.
 4. Unconnected/unauthorised persons shall not be allowed to enter the Examination Centre. They shall be treated as trespassers and dealt with as such. The Chief Supervisor shall, if necessary, issue a public notification prohibiting entry of such persons with specified limits from the Centre in consultation with local Police Authorities.
 5. If necessary The Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations shall forward at the appointed date, time and place to each Chief Supervisor.
 6. The downloading and photocopies of the question papers, if found necessary, shall be done by the Chief Supervisor taking every precaution for its confidentiality.
 7. The Chief Supervisor shall not hand over the question papers to invigilators / other persons appointed to conduct the examination 20 minutes prior to the commencement of the examination.
 8. The Chief Supervisor immediately after the conclusion of examination for that day shall dispatch the written Answer-books duly packed and sealed alongwith the control sheet and one copy of question paper containing roll numbers of the absentee / examinee or other any additional roll number(s) of a examinee(s) appearing from the Centre to the District Collection Centre or the University, as the case may be, as per the instructions issued by the University from time to time. In case control sheets are not issued, the Chief Supervisor shall use the DOCKETS forms supplied by the University.

The Chief Supervisor shall arrange the Answer-book(s) Roll Number wise and shall prepare the bundle of Answer-books examination-wise and

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paper-wise and medium-wise and wrap them in cloth and put his seal thereon. The Internal Supervisor shall check it and shall put his signature. The Chief Supervisor shall write on each bundle the details as given below :-

- (a) Name of the Centre with Code Number
- (b) Name of the Examination
- (c) Name of the Subject/Paper
- (d) Date of the Paper
- (e) Shift (First/Second)
- (f) Medium of the Answer-book(s)
- (g) Total number of Answer-books contained in the bundle.

Note :-

(A) *In the past, it has been observed that the number of Answer-books received from the Examination Centres did not tally, though in few cases, with the number reported to have been despatched by the Chief Supervisor. It is very necessary to ensure accuracy in this matter. Several cases of wrong recording of absentee numbers or total omission of recording of absentee numbers have been identified in the past. It has also been observed that certain Roll Number is reported to be absent, but during scrutiny the Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations is confronted with the actual Answer-book of that Roll Number. The Chief Supervisor, therefore, shall ensure that absentee Roll Numbers are correctly recorded without any omission in the absentee statements despatched to the Spot Valuation Centres alongwith Answer-books and to the Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations.*

(B) The Spot Valuation Centres have in the past reported that the Answer books were not securely packed. Utmost care is, therefore, be taken that the Answer-books are securely packed before being submitted to the District Collection Centres and the Spot Valuation Centres.

Reporting of Unfair Means Cases :

9. (A) All cases of use of unfair means at the examination as per ordinance No. 17 of 2008 and instructions issued by the University from time to time shall be forwarded by Registered-Post Acknowledgement Due on the **same day** to the Assistant Registrar (Disciplinary Action & Reassessment) in a sealed cover & shall **write No. 16 with a RED circle** around it on the top right corner of the sealed cover.

(B) Such cases shall be reported in Form-U and it shall contain :-

- (i) A statement in writing from the examinee. If the examinee refuses to give a statement, remark to that effect shall be made jointly by the Chief Supervisor and Internal Supervisor.
- (ii) A report of the Invigilator who first detected the use of unfair means, with a clear and precise statement of the circumstances of the case.

(iii) The detailed report of the Chief Supervisor which should include as to how far the writings on the respective Answer-book and the material paper, etc. seized from the examinee are relevant to the syllabus of the question paper and the questions set in the question paper of that day.

(C) Form U-I should be accompanied by the original Answer-book, alongwith another Answer-book given after seizing the original one. All documents seized from the examinee with his signature and Roll Number thereon alongwith the counter signature and seal of the Chief Supervisor, be also sent alongwith the U-I Form.

(D) The complete list of unfair means cases reported to be despatched within 24 hours after the conclusion of the examinations at the Centre. The Chief Supervisor should give, in the list, date-wise detailed account of the cases reported to the University.

(E) If an examinee is found in possession of any written or printed material on his person or if he is found copying from any such material, the Chief Supervisor will have the discretion to allow the

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examinee to take the remaining part of the examination to solve the paper in question. The original Answer-book be taken away from the examinee and a fresh Answer-book be given for remaining part of the examination to solve the question paper. The Chief Supervisor at his discretion, may give the examinee extra time equal to the time spent in the completion of all the formalities.

(F) If any examinee is found causing any disturbance in the Examination Hall or acting in indisciplined manner or causing any nuisance in the hall or thereabout, the Chief Supervisor may expell him for that paper and legal action be taken against him as a trespasser at the Examination Centre.

(G) If any non-examinee(s) and/or person(s) not authorized by a competent authority enter or try to enter the Examination Hall or Centre, legal action be taken against him/them as trespasser(s) at the Examination Centre.

10. Immediately on receipt of the attendance sheet Forms, the Chief Supervisor shall check carefully the Numerical Returns, Roll Lists. If any discrepancy is detected, the same should be reported immediately to the Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations.

11. The signature (with date) of the examinees present for the examination be obtained daily on the the Attendent sheet Forms. The Invigilator should write 'Absent' and not "AA" if the examinee remains absent and sign. Immediately on the closure of a particular examination at the Centre, the attendant sheet forms should be tagged (after arranging them Roll Number wise serially) and should be kept in Chief Supervisor's custody.

12. Many candidates are appearing with exemptions in some subjects for the examination. The Roll-Lists of Ex-students are prepared after thoroughly scrutinizing the application form at the University level. Despite this, the possibility of mistake in the exempted and non-exempted subject cannot be ruled out. It is, therefore, desirable that the candidate be allowed to have his option to appear in the subject in which he is not claiming exemption and undertaking should be taken from him that he will do so at his risk and the decision of the University will be final and binding on him/her. Undertaking

obtained from the examinees shall be submitted to the Dy. Registrar (Pre-Examinations) separately in a sealed cover examination wise. Under no circumstances the candidate be given an opportunity to complain to the University that he was compelled by the Chief Supervisor to appear or was disallowed to appear in the particular subject.

13. The Chief Supervisor shall display the "Instructions to Examinees" given in this booklet on the Notice Board of the College Centre under his signature. He shall bring to the notice of all examinees, through the Invigilator, the instructions given in paras. 57 to 60 daily.
14. The Chief Supervisor shall obtain undertaking from the Invigilator that they have carefully read and understood the instructions printed in this booklet. He shall give instructions to the Invigilator as mentioned in paras. 52, 53 and 56 daily.
15. He shall appoint required administrative staff such as clerk, menials, invigilator etc.
16. He shall take rounds of the various Examination Halls of the centre to avoid use of unfair means.
17. The Chief Supervisor shall provide at his level the facility of amanuensis/ writer to the blind examinee with extra time of one hour and to the physically handicapped examinee with extra time of half an hour over and above the stipulated time limit of the paper to write answers after verifying the Medical Certificate issued by the Civil Surgeon/Orthopaedic Surgeon. The writer should be lesser qualified than the blind / physically handicapped student.
18. The Chief Supervisor shall provide at his level the facility of giving extra half an hour, over and above the stipulated time of the paper, to write answers during the examination to the paraplegies, Orthopaedically handicapped students who have hand co-ordination problem and to the visually handicapped students after verification of Medical Certificate issued by the Civil Surgeon/Orthopaedic Surgeon.
19. The Chief Supervisor shall send to the Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations a list of concerned writers and examinees to whom the facilities under paras 17 & 18 above have been provided at the centre.

20. If the Internal Supervisor fails to report at the examination centre where he is appointed, the Principal of the college is authorised to appoint any qualified senior teacher either from his own college or from other colleges as Internal Supervisor untill further orders and report the matter immediately to the Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations.
21. The Chief Supervisor shall make the seating arrangement for Physically Handicapped examinees on the ground floor in the room of the examination centre.
22. The examinees are to be instructed not to bring with him / her any mobile / cell phone in the examination Hall. The Chief Supervisor shall open in the counter with token system to make the necessary arrangement of examinees if they bring mobile / cell phone to the examination centre.
23. (a) He shall be responsible for maintaining discipline amongst the students and staff and attending law and order problems at the centre.
(b) He shall not leave the centre without prior permission of the Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations during the examination period.
Provided that in case of emergency he shall make the substitute arrangement and obtain the approval of the Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations for the same before leaving the centre.
24. All expenses incurred in connection with the conduct of the examinations at a centre shall be borne by the University as per rules, for which purpose the Chief Supervisor may draw such advance from the University as he thinks proper through the Principal of his college. The Chief Supervisor shall submit a detailed account of the expenses incurred by him as soon as the examinations are over at his centre and in any case within 15 days of the date of the last paper at his centre. The account should be submitted in the prescribed forms supplied by the Finance & Accounts Officer of the University. He shall obtain copies of the rules and rates of remuneration from the Finance & Accounts Officer (if not supplied) for the conduct of examinations alongwith other forms mentioned above. He shall obtain the acknowledgement of submission of accounts from the Finance & Accounts Officer.

25. The Chief Supervisor should submit his remuneration bill alongwith his confidential report to the University Examination Section at the end of the examination in the prescribed format by enclosing xerox copies of his appointment letter and acknowledgement of submission of accounts.

C] Appointment of Internal Supervisor and His Duties

26. "Internal Supervisor" means an approved teacher having not less than five years teaching experience and not connected with the College where the examination is conducted, appointed by the University / Competent Authority.

Provided that in case of emergency a teacher having less than five years teaching experience may be appointed as Internal Supervisor with the permission of the Pro-Vice-Chancellor.

27. The Internal Supervisor shall be appointed from out side the College at each examination centre by a Committee constituted for the said purpose by the Board of Examinations & Evaluations. The Internal Supervisor so appointed shall give his acceptance within the prescribed time limit to the Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations. If no communication is received within the prescribed time limit it shall be presumed that the appointment as Internal Supervisor is accepted by the concerned teacher/ person.
28. The second Internal Supervisor may be appointed by the Committee as per the requirement of the examination centre, so as to assist the Principal / Chief Supervisor for smooth conduct of University examinations.
29. The Internal Supervisor(s) shall assist the Chief Supervisor of the examination centre for the conduct of the examination. The Internal Supervisor shall report to the Chief Supervisor of the University examination centre one day earlier, so as to ensure that the arrangements made for the conduct of examination are as per the norms laid down by the University from time to time.
30. He shall not leave the centre without prior permission of the Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations during the examination period.

31. The Internal Supervisor shall ensure that :-

- (i) All physical arrangements for smooth conduct of examination are adequately made.
- (ii) The Answer-books received by the Chief Supervisor are in good condition.
- (iii) Each Answer-book is Serially numbered.
- (iv) The pages of the Answer-book are serially numbered.
- (v) The Answer-book do not have any loose page(s).
- (vi) The Answer-book having loose page(s), answer book having pages without serial number, answer book without sr. number on cover page etc. are cancelled by the Chief Supervisor.
- (vii) The instructions are issued to each Invigilator daily to check the condition of each Answer-book supplied to an examinee before noting his roll number and Answer-book serial number issued to him and in case the Answer-book is defective, it should be brought to the notice of the Chief Supervisor for cancellation.
- (viii) The control attendant sheets to be downloaded from website/portal**
- (ix) The absentee numbers of the examinees are recorded on the control sheets correctly and each control sheet alongwith the absentee roll number is dispatched alongwith the concerned Answer-book bundle.
- (x) Instruction / Direction issued by the University from time to time are faithfully followed or carried out.
- (xi) Necessary co-operation to be given to the Vigilance Squad(s) or person(s) authorised by Board or Members of the Board in carrying out the inspection of the examination centre during conduct of examination.
- (xii) Unfair means cases are to be immediately reported to the University.
- (xiii) To submit a detailed report to University about the functioning of the examination centre and the co-operation given by the Principal, Teachers and Management of the College for smooth conduct of examinations.

32. The Internal Supervisor shall take rounds of the examination halls keeping direct contact with the Invigilators (including the relieving invigilators) and instruct them from time to time with regard to check the following information written by the examinees on their Answer-books :-
- (1) Roll Number in figures as well as in words.
 - (2) Name of Examination.
 - (3) Enrolment Number etc.
33. Before the Answer-books are despatched to the District Collection Centres/ university godown he will personally check that all the Answer-books are arranged serially subject-wise, paper-wise and medium-wise in suitable bundles alongwith the list of absentee examinees and total number of examinees appeared as per docket / control sheets. He shall also check randomly that all entries on the cover page of the answer-books are correctly filled in by the examinees.
34. If the Internal Supervisor encounters any difficulties in the working at the Examination centre, he shall communicate it to the Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations directly and endorse a copy of his communication to the Chief Supervisor for his information.
35. He shall inform the Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations confidentially regarding malpractices and unfair means going on at the centre.
36. He shall remain at the Head-quarters during the conduct of the examinations.
37. He shall be present atleast half an hour before the commencement of the examination and half an hour after the end of the examination at the centre.
38. He shall ensure that the menial staff and water-boys are attending their duties punctually and are in continuous attendance throughout the period of examination.
39. The Internal Supervisor should submit his T. A. Bill to the University at the end of the entire examination through the Chief Supervisor in the prescribed format alongwith xerox copy of his appointment letter.

D] Joint Responsibilities of the Chief Supervisor and the Internal Supervisor

40. At the close of every paper, the Answer-books shall be serially arranged and its bundle shall be sealed with a certificate in the prescribed form.
41. They shall ensure that the Answer-books in good condition are distributed to examinees atleast 10 minutes before the start of examination. The account of Answer-books used alongwith serial number shall be maintained by the Chief Supervisor and shall be checked by the Internal Supervisor. After getting himself satisfied Internal Supervisor shall sign on the Answer-books account maintained by the Chief Supervisor.
42. At the end of the examination it shall be the duty of the Chief Supervisor and also the Internal Supervisor to submit the detailed report to the Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations regarding the account of the Answer-books and question papers downloaded by the Centre.
43. They shall give required information and necessary co-operation to the members of Director, Board of Examinations & Evaluations and Vigilance Squad(s) appointed during their visits.
44. They shall co-operate with the committee appointed as per Section 48(5) (a) of the M. P. U. Act, 2016 to investigate and to take disciplinary action for malpractices and lapses.

E] Special Instructions for Chief Supervisor/Internal Supervisor

45. No person shall act as Chief Supervisor or Internal Supervisor at such centre where his/her *near relative is to appear or likely to appear for examination.

(*Near Relation shall mean and include son, daughter, father, mother, brother, sister, wife, husband, uncle, aunt, nephew, niece, brother-in-law, first cousin and the direct dependants of the Chief Supervisor / Internal Supervisor).
46. The University shall make arrangements for the inspection of Examination Centres by persons authorised by it. Physical search of students for any incriminating material may be provided at doors of the examination hall if found extremely necessary. The Chief Supervisor/Internal Supervisor of the Centre shall have the power to search students in the examination hall, if he finds it necessary.

47. If there is a prima facie evidence of improper conduct of examination at the Centre or Sub-Centre, the particular paper at the said Centre or Sub-Centre may be cancelled by the Board of Examinations & Evaluations for that Centre only.
48. If more than one examination are to be conducted at a Centre simultaneously, the examinees should be seated in alternate rows. However in no case, two examinees appearing for the same examination shall be seated on the single bench & side by side.
49. The affiliated Colleges shall be under obligation to the University to make available the services of all teaching and non-teaching employees and its premises, furniture and other essential facilities for conducting examinations as per provision of Section 108 (1) (g) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016.
50. It shall be obligatory on every teacher and on the non-teaching employee of the University, affiliated, conducted or autonomous College or recognised institution to render necessary assistance and service in respect of examinations of the University. If any teacher or non-teaching employee fails to comply with the order of the University or College or Institution, in this respect, it shall be treated as misconduct and the employee shall be liable for disciplinary action, as per provision of Section 48 (4) (g) of M. P. U. Act, 2016.
51. During periods of examinations Police help may be sought from the following officials :
 - (A) The Commissioner of Police, Nagpur for Centres in the City of Nagpur.
 - (B) The D. I. G. Police, Nagpur Circle, for Centres in the outlying Districts in University jurisdiction.
52. If any person associated with the conduct of examination at the centre including Chief Supervisor, Internal Supervisor is / are found failing in his / their duties, or directly or indirectly helping the examinee(s) in the use of unfair means at the examination etc., the appropriate authority shall take proper action in each case.

53. In case of emergency, the Chief Supervisor/Internal Supervisor may contact the concerned Officer in the Examination Section, Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University (in the office during office hours and at the residence after office hours) on their telephone/mobile no. as stated in the enclosed Annexure - I.

F. Appointment of Invigilators & His/Her Duties

54. (A) Invigilators at the University Examination Centres shall be appointed from the following persons in order of preference in which they are named:

- (a) Teachers including Physical Training Instructors of College,
- (b) Graduate Teachers of Recognized Schools,
- (c) Members of the Bar,
- (d) Other Graduates with the special permission of the Vice-Chancellor.

The Invigilators shall be selected by the Chief Supervisor of the Centre. Atleast 25% of the total Invigilators for Centre at Nagpur shall be other than those who are teachers in the College where the Centre is located. For Centres Outside Nagpur, the Chief Supervisor shall select atleast 50% Invigilators from other Colleges, Recognised Schools and from the Members of the Bar.

- (B) For every thirty examinees or less, there shall be one Invigilator. The Chief Supervisor shall have the power to appoint a reliever.

55. The invigilator shall daily instruct the examinees that :

- (a) They shall write their Roll Number in figures and also in words either in Hindi or Marathi or English on the front page of Answer-book.
- (b) Before the question papers are distributed they should not write anything on the Answer-book, except their Roll Number, Enrolment No., Registration No., Subject, Paper and Date of Examination, at the places provided for the purpose.
- (c) They shall read carefully instructions on the inside cover page of the Answer-book.
- (e) Warning bell will be given ten minutes before the concluding time of the examination.

(f) Examinees shall not be allowed to leave the Examination Hall, unless all the Answer-books are collected by the Invigilators at the conclusion of the paper(s).

(g) Examinee shall not write anything on the question paper supplied to him/her.

56. The invigilators shall check that the examinee(s) has written their Roll Number(s) correctly in figure(s) and in words on their Answer-book(s).

57. The invigilator who detects the use of unfair means shall submit his report to the Chief Supervisor with a clear and precise statement of the circumstances of the case.

58. (a) The invigilator should write 'Absent' and not "AA" if the examinee remains absent and sign on the attendance sheet.

(b) The invigilator shall check the admission card of the examinee during the examination. The invigilator shall check the identity of the examinee and obtain his signature on the attendance sheet.

59. (a) The invigilator shall sign on the last written page of each Answer-book at the end of the paper and he shall cancel the blank pages of the Answer-book by drawing a line across the blank page(s).

(b) He shall sortout the Answer-book examination wise/paper wise/medium wise & then arrange roll number wise for handing over to Chief Supervisor.

G] Instructions to Examinees

60. (a) Examinee shall write his/her Roll Number either in Hindi or Marathi or English in figures as well as in words.

(b) The examinee should not write anything on the Answer-book, except their Roll Number, Enrolment No., Registration No., Subject, Paper and Date of Examination, at the places provided for the purpose, before he receives the question papers.

61. The examinees should read the instructions on the inside cover page of the Answer-book carefully and write their answers on both sides of the leaf of Answer-book supplied.

62. (a) A warning bell will be given ten minutes before the concluding time of the examination.

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- (b) During the last 10 minutes before the concluding time of the examinations, examinee(s) shall not leave the Examination hall, unless the Answer-books of all the examinees are collected by the Invigilators at the end of the paper(s).
63. Examination will be held on the dates and time mentioned in the Programme / Time-Table of the Examination.
64. Examination hall shall be open half an hour before the prescribed time on the first day of the examination; and 15 minutes before on the succeeding days.
65. Entry without the Admission Card is prohibited. Admission Card may be checked during the examination.
66. The candidate must be in his/her seat in the hall 10 minutes before the commencement of the examination. However, the Chief Supervisor at his discretion may allow a late-comer upto half an hour thereafter.
67. Every candidate shall maintain peace in the Examination Hall.
68. Examinee shall not bring with him/her any book(s), written / printed papers or any objectionable material etc. in the examination hall.
69. Before writing the Roll No. on the Answer-book the examinee shall observe the condition of the Answer-book. If found bad, containing loose pages, pages are not serially numbered, Answer-book is without serial number on its cover page etc. then he shall bring the discrepancy to the notice of the Invigilator / Chief Supervisor immediately, and obtain new Answer-book.
70. Examinee shall not write anything on the question paper supplied to him/her.
71. No Examinee shall be allowed :-
- (a) to leave his/her seat within the first half an hour.
 - (b) to submit his/her Answer-book before completion of an hour from the starting of the examination.

72. Examinee shall leave the hall only after handing over his/her Answer-book to the Invigilator. The Examinee who has submitted the Answer-book and left the Examination hall, will not be allowed to enter the Examination Hall again.
73. Examinee shall sign the Attendance Sheet.
74. Examinee found using unfair means or violating the rules shall be liable for punishment by Board of Examinations & Evaluations of the University.
75. Examinee will not ordinarily be allowed to change the centre.
76. Duplicate Admission Card will be issued on submission of "No Objection Certificate" from his/her Principal alongwith payment of prescribed fee.
77. Facility of lesser qualified amanuensis/writer to the Blind and physically handicapped students can be availed by the examinee after submitting Original Medical Certificate issued by the Civil Surgeon/Orthopaedic Surgeon for verification to the Chief Supervisor of their respective Examination Centres.

Facility of one additional hour (over and above the stipulated time limit of the paper) to the writer of the blind examinee and extra-half an hour (over and above the stipulated time limit of the paper) to the writer of physically handicapped examinee can also be availed.

The examinee / student should obtain prior permission well in advance from the Chief Supervisor of his centre by submitting necessary documents/certificates.

78. Facility of extra half an hour (over and above the stipulated time of the paper) to write answers during the examination can be availed by paraplegies; orthopaedically handicapped examinees who have hand co-ordination problem / visually handicapped examinees.

These examinees should obtain prior permission well in advance from the Chief Supervisor of their respective centres before the commencement of the examination by submitting Original Medical Certificate issued by the Civil Surgeon/Orthopaedic Surgeon for verification.

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79. The Chief Supervisor/Internal Supervisor/Invigilator or any person authorised by the University shall have the power to take physical search of the examinees during the examination. Physical search of female examinees shall be taken only by the Lady Invigilator / Lady Member of the Vigilance Squad.
80. The examinees shall not bring with them any Mobile / Cell Phone in the examination hall.
81. Loitering in the verandahs is strictly prohibited. The Motorcycle should be parked in the parking Place. Vehicles Stand to be provided to examinees free of cost by Centre / college authorities.




