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

Relevance of Dalton Teaching Plan in India

Concept :

This plan was originated and developed by Ms. Helen Parkhurst. The Dalton plan derives its name from the Dalton High School, Massachusetts (USA) Dalton is the name of the town where the school is located. It is also called a Laboratory Plan. Her aim was to create a new type of educational society by putting boys and girls under entirely different conditions of living from those provided in the ordinary class room and to re-organize the community life of the school

There are five main features of this Plan

- 1) Assignment or Contracts
- 2) Subject Teacher
- 3) Subject Laboratories
- 4) Records
- 5) Conferences

Assignment or Contract : The teacher should outline the work to be done of the year in his subject to enable the students to know about the scope and nature of the work they are required to complete in each subject. The work is further subdivided into suitable monthly units by the subject teacher, while preparing the assignment the teacher must consider the factors like holidays, time available, co-curricular activities and the revision to be taken etc. Each unit of work is considered as a "Contract" and he has to promise to complete the work and to satisfy the teacher before going to the next unit. In this plan every subject has its own assignment. The new assignment is given when the student completes his earlier assignment. In this a student is free to choose any assignment of any subject first, i.e. he may give one week to complete his assignment of one subject and may ignore other assignments of other subjects. He may complete other subjects in the second, third, fourth week. Or he may spend the whole day in one assignment of a subject and so on. The only limitation is that he must finish the whole contract before the second contract is entered upon.

Subject Teachers : The Dalton plan gives emphasis on specialist teachers instead of class teachers. Each specialist teacher supervises each child in his subject and guides his work. He must provide all possible help to the student to complete his assignment

Subjects Laboratories : The plan scraps classrooms and gives their place to subject rooms which are called subject laboratories. Each specialist is incharge of his room. Each subject room must be adequately equipped with the material required in that subject. It contains books and magazines, charts, maps, models, apparatus and appliances related to that subject.

Records : Graphs are kept to show the work done by each student in each subject so that the student himself and teachers may know how he is progressing. These records serve as a mirror to indicate the work of the student and are kept up to date

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
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
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
