#### **Agenda**


1. To make the students aware with organisational culture and values of the institution.

- 2) Dr. Neha Bhandari said that considering the current scenario, programs should be undertaken, wherein not only Principal, Vice-Principal would be present to guide all













teaching and non teaching staff, but experts would also be invited to talk on Professional ethics. It was decided that different programs would be organized for them.
